1. Service Details

The College provides a Driveway Service available for students to travel to and from the College during the School Term. All buses are operated by experienced drivers, specially chosen to meet the very high standards set by the College. All buses are equipped with mobile phones for emergency communications. The exact route that each bus takes is determined by the College according to the addresses of the students using the service.

The bus aims to be at the College by 8.25am each morning and the majority of students are picked up between 7.00am and 8.00am. Buses leave the College by 3.25pm each afternoon and most students are dropped off between 4.00pm and 5.00pm. Students living in outer areas may be collected earlier and/or dropped off later than these times, however we will endeavour to minimise the travelling time of all students.

2. Fares & Payments

In 2019, the pricing will be retained at the equivalent of \$5.00 per one-way trip as in 2018. The Driveway Bus Service will require a full term's commitment from each student. No adjustments will be made to Bus Fares payable due to absences or changes in personal circumstances that result in a scheduled service not being utilised.

Bus Fares for each student will be individually calculated based upon the Weekdays and Route Options selected. Payment for each Term's Bus Fares must be made by the end of Week 1 each Term. Periodic Payment Plans are only available under a formal arrangement which must be approved in advance by the College and payable at the same frequency as Tuition Fee Payments. Any payments made on the family account will firstly be applied to any Tuition Fees outstanding.

3. Eligibility for Travel

All Junior Campus students must be accompanied by an older sibling studying at the College's Senior Campus or alternatively approved for travel by the College Principal in advance. The College, at its exclusive discretion, may cancel any student's eligibility for travel on the College bus at any time for reasons including but not limited to overdue accounts or behavioural concerns. Early Learning Centre students are not eligible for travel on the College bus.

4. Bookings & Notice of Changes

Please contact the College on 8159 8100 or stgeorgecollege@sgc.sa.edu.au to make a booking for the Any requests for additional services should be made in accordance with the provisions regarding Casual Bus Travel at Item 6. Our driver may be contacted 0428 494 560 for emergencies or in the event of unforeseen cancellations outside of College reception operating hours of 8:00am to 4:00pm, however should not be contacted in relation to bookings. **A full term's notice must be given in writing to stgeorgecollege@sgc.sa.edu.au to request cancellation of any services.**

5. Nominated Carer (PM Services Only)

Each family must nominate a person who will be responsible for the student(s) care upon delivery to their residential address. All Students in Years 4 and below must be met by their nominated carer before the bus can depart. In the event that the nominated carer changes on any given day, advice must be provided by contacting the College's Senior Campus Reception on 8159 8100 before 2:00pm on the day of service. Notwithstanding this notice requirement, a student's Primary Caregiver must be contactable at all times after school hours until driveway service is completed.

6. Casual Bus Travel

Anything less than one standard scheduled weekday service, for each week throughout any School Term, is considered to be Casual Bus Travel. Casual Bus Travel is subject to availability of space and only by prior arrangement with the College. Fares for Casual Bus Travel are set at a minimum of 20% higher than standard equivalent of \$5.00 per one-way trip, and may attract higher fares if the bus is required to make a material deviation or extension to the standard route. Requests for Casual Bus Travel should be in advance made to the College's Senior Campus Reception on 8159 8100, not later than 2:00pm on the day prior to the requested date of service.
